The Historical Society will not be having the Annual Christmas tour this year due to the lack of a Chairperson!

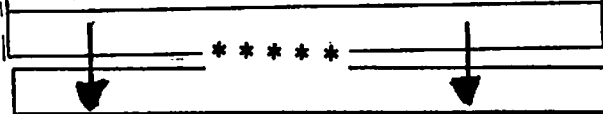

1 cup shortening 1 cup white sugar 1 cup brown sugar 2 eggs
2 cups potato chips, crushed 1 cup chopped nuts or coconut or raisins
2 cups flour 1 tsp. Baking soda 1 tsp salt Bake in a 325 degree oven

Cream shortening and sugars, add eggs, salt and soda, add to first mixture, last add crushed potato chips and nuts. Shape into small balls, press down on ungreased cookie sheet with a floured bottom of a glass. May make as a drop cookie.
